

Sliding Fee Discount Schedule

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Effective Date: 8/28/26 **Based on:** 2026 U.S. Department of Health and Human Services Federal Poverty Guidelines (Federal Register, Vol. 91, No. 10, January 15, 2026), 48 contiguous states and District of Columbia. **Annual Review:** This Sliding Fee Schedule is reviewed and updated annually within sixty (60) days of publication of the most current Federal Poverty Guidelines.

How to Use This Schedule

The percentages below represent the discount applied to the Practice's standard fee schedule for each service provided. Each dollar amount in the table is the **maximum** annual household income for that column's discount tier. To determine your discount:

1. Identify your family size (count yourself and all related family members residing in your household; see Sliding Fee Discount Program Policy for full definition).
2. Find the row matching your family size.
3. Reading across your row from left to right, find the **first column** whose income amount is **equal to or greater than** your annual household gross income (before taxes).
4. The percentage at the top of that column is your discount on the Practice's standard fees.

Example: for a family of 6 with an annual household income of \$80,000, the first column equal to or greater than \$80,000 is \$84,284 (190% FPG), so the discount is 20%.

Discounts apply to: psychological screening and assessment, psychological evaluation, treatment planning, care coordination, individual psychotherapy, and family psychotherapy.

How the Discount Is Applied

Discounts are applied to the Practice's standard published fee schedule. For example, if the Practice's standard fee for an individual therapy session is \$200, and the patient qualifies for a 60% discount, the patient's responsibility for that session is \$80 ($\$200 \times 0.40 = \80).

The Practice maintains its standard fee schedule for all services and provides patients with the applicable discounted fee at the time of scheduling and again at the time of service.

Notes

1. **No nominal charge:** Patients with household incomes at or below 100% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines receive a 100% discount and are not charged for SFDP-eligible services.
2. **No one is denied services for inability to pay.** Patients who are unable to pay their discounted fee at the time of service may request a payment plan, which the Practice will accommodate without limitation on access to future services.
3. **Eligibility determined by application.** This Schedule applies only after a patient has completed the Sliding Fee Discount Application and has been determined eligible by the Practice. See the Sliding Fee Discount Program Policy for full eligibility procedures.
4. **Annual re-evaluation.** Patients are required to update their application at least every twelve (12) months and any time their family size or income materially changes.
5. **Confidentiality.** All financial information collected for SFDP eligibility is protected health information under HIPAA and is maintained confidentially.
